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Program Background

This report is the 2021 and 2022 review of the Incentive Award Program.¹ It contains a list of incentive awards agencies granted during fiscal years 2021 and 2022 with the corresponding savings to the state or improvements in the effectiveness of state government.

The Incentive Award Program recognizes and rewards individuals and teams of state employees as well as non-employees for innovations that significantly contribute to eliminating or reducing an agency's expenditures or improve the effectiveness of state government or services to the public by permitting more work to be accomplished without increasing the cost of governmental operations.

Agencies may present incentive awards in the form of money, paid leave, or other forms of non-monetary recognition.

The program is a result of legislation enacted in 1993.² Each agency administers its own incentive award program. An agency head may choose to grant incentive awards and determine their monetary value. The public may also submit ideas to improve government operations and become eligible to receive an incentive award.
